

**ORDINANCE 2020-06 CONSENTING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF SAVANNA BOWENS AS TEMPORARY FISCAL CLERK FOR THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND, PICKAWAY COUNTY, OHIO AND SETTING THE RESIDENCY AND THE WAGE FOR THE POSITION AND DECLARING IT TO BE AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, The Council of the Village of New Holland, Pickaway County, Ohio, is authorized to set the hours and the rate of pay for the Utility Billing Clerk of Court Clerk, and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section (ref. 731.13) of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the Council of the Village of New Holland, to fix the compensation of all employees of the Village of New Holland

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation of the municipality and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the municipality that this ordinance take effect at the earliest possible date, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of New Holland, Pickaway County, Ohio, as follows:

**SECTION I:** That the rate of pay for the part time position as Fiscal Officer is set at Fifteen Dollars and No Cents (\$15.00) per hour and will work a minimum of 38 hours per week, Any hours in excess of the minimum of hours will be paid at the hourly rate of \$15.00 per hour and must be approved by the Mayor or the Village Administrator. Pay dates will be weekly. On the anniversary date of hire each year shall receive a 3% increase starting on September 21, 2021 Hours work shall be recorded on the weekly time card according to the following;

- a. All hours shall be recorded on the weekly time card and shall be distributed to the following funds,
  - General Fund 1000-710 calculated at 30%.
  - Street Fund 2011 calculated at 10%.
  - Water Fund 5101 calculated at 30%
  - Sewer Fund 5201 calculated at 30%

This will be effective January 1, 2019.

**SECTION II:** This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the Village, or providing for the usual daily operation of the financial area and for the further reason that prompt action is necessary to protect the public and the Village; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor;
