

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2018-05 PROVIDING FOR THE UPDATED WAGES OF PUBLIC UTILITY OPERATOR FOR WATER, SEWER AND STREETS IN THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND.

WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of New Holland, is authorized to provide for the position of Public Utility Operator; and

WHEREAS, Section 731-13 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the Council of the Village of New Holland, is authorized to fix the compensation of all employees of the Village of New Holland

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND, OHIO, THAT:

Section I: That there is hereby created the position of full time Public Utility Operator for the Village of New Holland; and

Section II: That the compensation for the position of Public Utility Operator shall be according to yearly review by Village Administrator. Based on the review. the wage progression will be based on the following:

Section IV: That Ordinance 2018-05 and any other existing Ordinances or parts specifically in conflict, herewith of the Village of New Holland, Ohio, are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of New Holland, insofar as there is a necessity to provide for the daily services in the Village Public Works Department, and shall go into full force and effect upon passage by the Council of the Village of New Holland, Pickaway County, Ohio.
