

ORDINANCE 2021-11 REVISING THE APPOINTMENT OF CARMEN WHITE AS PART TIME FISCAL CLERK FOR THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND, PICKAWAY COUNTY, OHIO TO CORRECT THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE FUNDS TO BE IN LINE WITH STANDARD FISCAL OFFICER DISTRIBUTION AND DECLARING IT TO BE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of New Holland, Pickaway County, Ohio, has determined that there is a need to authorize a Fiscal Officers and salary.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 731.1.1 of the Ohio Revised Code, the legislative authority of a village shall fix the compensation for the Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation of the municipality and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the municipality that this ordinance take effect at the earliest possible date, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND, THAT:

SECTION I: That the rate of pay for the part time position as Fiscal Officer is set at Fifteen Dollars and No Cents (\$15.00) per hour and will work a minimum of 18 hours and a maximum of 25 hours per week, Any hours in excess of the maximum of hours will be paid at the hourly rate of \$15.00 per hour and must be approved by the Mayor or the Village Administrator. Pay dates will be weekly. On the anniversary date of hire each year shall receive a 3% increase starting on September 21, 2021 Hours work shall be recorded on the weekly time card according to the following;

- a. All hours shall be recorded on the weekly time card and shall be distributed to the following funds,
 - General Fund 1000-710 calculated at 10%.
 - Street Fund 2011 calculated at 10%.
 - Water Fund 5101 calculated at 40%
 - Sewer Fund 5201 calculated at 40%

This will be effective January 1, 2021.

SECTION II: That this Ordinance Amends 2018-10 and any other existing Ordinances/Resolutions or parts specifically in conflict, herewith of the Village of New Holland, Ohio, are hereby repealed.

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon passage by the Council of the Village of New Holland, Pickaway County, Ohio.
