

AN ORDINANCE CONSENTING TO THE SETTING OF A WAGE AND HOURS FOR POLICE OFFICERS, FOR THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND, OHIO AND DECLARING IT TO BE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of New Holland, Ohio is authorized by statute to establish wages for the Police Officers thereto; and

WHEREAS, Section (ref. 731.08 and 731.13) of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the Council of the Village of New Holland, to fix the compensation of Village Officials, for the Village of New Holland, Pickaway County, Ohio

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: In accordance with Ohio Revised Code, Section 731.08 and 731-13 the wages for the Police Officers shall be according to the Wage set by the council, with the amount to be \$16.00 per hour. The wages shall become effective as of May 22, 2023.

SECTION 2: The number of hours is set at twenty-four (24) hours per week and can be divided between more than one or more officer's, but the total of hours may not exceed twenty-four (24) hours and will be supported by revenue received from fines and forfeitures.

SECTION 3: The Police Chief will distribute the hours as he sees fit and will assign it to as many officers that are willing to work the hours scheduled.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance repeals any other existing Ordinances or Resolutions parts specifically in conflict with, herewith of the Village of New Holland, Ohio, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and it is there by necessary for the preservation of the safety and welfare of the Village for the reason that said Village must have a Police Officers scheduled at certain times as scheduled by the Police Chief and is in immediate need of the same, and said Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval. The effectiveness of Ordinance will be reviewed every ninety days starting May 22, 2023.


