

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE WAGES FOR A FULL TIME CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND, OHIO. AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND TO SET STIPEND PAY FOR AUXILIARY OFFICERS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of New Holland, Ohio is authorized by statute to establish wages for a full time Chief of Police thereto; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 731.08 authorizes the Council of the Village of New Holland, to determine the number of employees and to fix the compensation for such employees for the Village of New Holland, Pickaway County, Ohio.

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of New Holland has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village and its residents to require the position of the Village of New Holland Police Chief to be a full-time salaried position.

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of New Holland has determined that the immediate hiring of a full-time Chief of Police is necessary to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of New Holland and, as such, an emergency exists for the passage of this legislation without delay.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND, OHIO, THAT:

- SECTION 1: In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 731.07, the Council for the Village of New Holland shall require the position of the Village of New Holland Chief of Police to be a full-time position.
- SECTION 2.: In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 731.07, the salary of the Village of New Holland Chief of Police, shall be a base salary of up to \$44,000.00. Council shall allocate and appropriate an additional \$6,000.00 for health insurance benefits for the position.
- SECTION 3: The Chief of Police shall be a salaried position, with minimum hours worked to be no less than 40 hours in a week.
- SECTION 4: The Council Authorizes the Village of New Holland Mayor, to set stipend pay amounts for the Auxiliary Officers subject to appropriation of such funds by Council. Council also delegates and authorizes the Mayor, with consultation of the Chief of Police, to set the terms, conditions, and requirements for Auxiliary Officers per Ohio Revised Code, Section 737.051.
- SECTION 5: This Ordinance repeals any other existing Ordinances or Resolutions for wages, or parts specifically in conflict with, herewith of the Village of New Holland, Ohio, are hereby repealed.
- SECTION 6: The Council for the Village of New Holland has determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of New Holland and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
