

AN ORDINANCE CONSENTING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF JASON LAWLESS AS CHIEF OF POLICE, FOR THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND, PICKAWAY COUNTY, OHIO, AND DECLARING IT TO BE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, In accordance with Section 737.15, Ohio Revised Code, Each village shall have a marshal, designated chief of police, appointed by the mayor with the advice and consent of the legislative authority of the village, who need not be a resident of the village at the time of appointment but shall become a resident thereof within six months after appointment by the mayor and confirmation by the legislative authority unless such residence requirement is waived by ordinance;

WHEREAS, In accordance with Section 737.15, Ohio Revised Code, Mayor Troy Hupp has recommended the initial appointment of Jason Lawless as marshal, designated chief of police, for the Village of New Holland, Ohio, effective immediately; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that the initial appointment of Jason Lawless as marshal, designated chief of police, is in the best interest of the Village of New Holland, Ohio;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: In accordance with Section 737.05, Ohio Revised Code, the police department of each city shall be composed of a chief of police and such other officers, patrolmen, and employees as the legislative authority thereof provides by ordinance.

SECTION 2: In accordance with Section 737.15, Ohio Revised Code, Council hereby consents to the initial appointment of Jason Lawless as marshal, designated chief of police, effective immediately; and

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance amends any other existing Ordinances or parts specifically in conflict, herewith of the Village of New Holland, Ohio, are hereby amended.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance waives the requirement that the Marshal, Chief of Police, need to be a resident in the Village of New Holland.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said Village of New Holland for the reason the immediate Police Chief be appointed and shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period permitted by law.
