

CONSENTING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF MICHELE ERVIN AS PART TIME CLERK OF COURTS FOR THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND, PICKAWAY COUNTY, OHIO AND SETTING THE RESIDENCY AND THE WAGE FOR THE POSITION AND DECLARING IT TO BE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of New Holland, Pickaway County, Ohio, is authorized to set the hours and the rate of pay for the Court Clerk, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section (ref. 731.13) of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the Council of the Village of New Holland, to fix the compensation of all employees of the Village of New Holland

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation of the municipality and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the municipality that this ordinance take effect at the earliest possible date, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of New Holland, Pickaway County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION I: In accordance with Ohio Revised Code, Section 731.07 the hourly rate of pay for the Part-time position as Clerk of Courts is set at Twelve Dollars (\$12.00). per hour and will work a Minimum of fifteen (15), with a Maximum of twenty (20) hours per week, with a schedule to be set by the Mayor or Village Chief of Police, and includes all the part-time benefits listed in the Personnel Policies and Procedures. Any hours in excess twenty (20) hours must be approved by the Mayor. Pay dates will be weekly. On the anniversary date of hire each year may receive a 3% increase. Hours work shall be recorded on the weekly time card and posted according to the following;

- a. All hours shall be recorded on the weekly time card and shall be distributed to the following funds,
 - General Fund 1000-110 for Mayor’s Court Clerk, duties, calculated at 100%

SECTION II: That this Ordinance Amends any other existing Ordinances/Resolutions or parts specifically in conflict, herewith of the Village of New Holland, Ohio, are hereby repealed.

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon passage by the Council of the Village of New Holland, Pickaway County, Ohio.
