

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PICKAWAY COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF THE QUESTION OF LEVYING AN ADDITIONAL TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION AND FOR THE FUNDING OF THE NEW HOLLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING THIS TO BE AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of New Holland, Pickaway County, Ohio, has determined that there is a need to authorize the Pickaway County Board of elections to submit to the elector of the Village of New Holland an additional levy for the operations of the New Holland police department, M. Betz certify the amounts that a levy to be placed on the November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021 ballot for the Police Department Operating fund pursuant R.C 5705.03 for the Village of New Holland, Pickaway County, Ohio.

WHEREAS the amount of taxes which may be raised within ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide adequate amount of the necessary requirements of police protection of the village of New Holland, Pickaway/Fayette Ohio.

WHEREAS, the Village Council finds that the order to provide adequate funds for the operation for of its police department, it is necessary to approve an additional levy of (\$.001) one mil for each one dollar evaluation for (5) five year period; and

WHEREAS, On June 24, 2022 the Village Council adopted a Resolution to submit to the electors of the Village of New Holland a additional Levy for operation of the Police department Outside the ten-mill limitation, and

WHEREAS The Pickaway County Auditor has certified to the Village Council that the total current tax valuation of the Village of New Holland is \$.001 Mil for each one dollar of valuation of revenue that will be produced annually by the millage stated for 5 years would be \$12,188 per Year (Attached as Exhibit A).

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND, THAT:**

**SECTION I:** That the Village of New Holland Council, Pickaway County, Ohio does authorize the Pickaway County Board of election to submit to the electors of the Village Of New Holland the certified amounts that a 1 mil Police Department Levy would be: and will be for the providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings used directly in the operation of a police department, for the payment of salaries of permanent or part-time police, communications, or administrative personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.33 of the Revised Code, for tax years 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025 and 2026, payable in the calendar years 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026 and 2027: and

**SECTION II:** This Resolution is passed pursuant to Section 5705.19(J) of the Ohio Revised Code. The additional Police levy would bring in \$12,127 per year for a five-year period. Police Department Levy would be: and will be for the providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings used directly in the operation of a police department, for the payment of salaries of permanent or part-time police, communications, or administrative personnel to operate the Levy will commence in Tax year 2022 payable in calendar year 2023 and

**SECTION III:** That the question approving the additional levy shall be submitted to the elector's of the village of New Holland at the general election to be held on November 8, 2022 and that said additional levy be placed on the tax lists commencing in tax year 2022 first due in the calendar year of 2023 by the major of elector voting.

**SECTION IV:** The Village of New Holland has submitted a resolution to certify the funds for the additional levy to the Pickaway County Auditor and the Pickaway county Board of election in the manner prescribed by the Ohio Revised code governing submission of the question to the Electors

**SECTION V:** This resolution shall be deemed an emergency measure, effective immediately upon passage of the Electra of the Village of New Holland and necessary for the health, welfare, And preservation of safety of the Residence Village of New Holland. and this submission the board of election by the August 10th, 2022 deadline. To be on the Ballot for November 8th, 2022.

**SECTION VI:** That this Resolution and any other existing Resolutions or parts specifically in conflict, herewith of the Village of New Holland, Ohio, are hereby repealed.

**SECTION VII:** This Resolution shall go into full force and effect upon passage by the Council of the Village of New Holland, Pickaway County, Ohio.
