

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF THE QUESTION OF LEVYING A TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF 1.0 MILLS IN EXCESS OF THE 10 MILL LIMITATION TO RUN FOR A DEFINITE PERIOD OF FIVE (5) YEARS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAINTAINING AND OPERATING THE NEW HOLLAND UNION CEMETERY WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND, AND DECLARING IT TO BE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of New Holland, Ohio has previously adopted a resolution requesting certification of the County Auditor as to the total current tax valuation of the Village of New Holland and the dollar amount of revenue that will be generated by 1.0 mills, a copy of which resolution was certified to the County Auditor of Pickaway County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the County Auditor has certified to the Village that the total current tax valuation of the Village of New Holland is \$12,187,930 and the dollar amount of revenue that will be produced annually by the millage stated below would be \$8,977; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of New Holland is desirous of proceeding with the submission to the electors of the question of levying a tax in the amount of 1.0 mills in excess of the 10 mill limitation for the purpose of maintaining and operating the cemetery;

WHEREAS, It is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation on the taxable property of the Village of New Holland, Pickaway/Fayette County, Ohio, for a definite period of five (5) years (tax years 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026) at a rate authorized by law for the purpose of maintaining and operating the New Holland Union Cemetery in the Village of New Holland:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of New Holland, Pickaway/Fayette County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION I: That the Council of the Village of New Holland desires and determines to proceed with the submission to the electors of the question of levying a tax in excess of the 10 mill limitation for the purpose of maintaining and operating the cemetery at a rate not exceeding 1.0 mills for each \$1.00 of valuation, which amounts to ten cents (\$.10) for each one hundred dollar (\$100.00) valuation of the taxable property within the Village of New Holland for a definite five (5) year period tax years 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025 and 2026, payable in the calendar years 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026 and 2027 of time to be levied in 2022 and collected in 2023, and thereafter as permitted in Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19.

SECTION II: This Resolution is passed pursuant to Section 5705.19(T) of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III: That the Fiscal Officer of the Village of New Holland be, and hereby is, directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections of Pickaway County, Ohio, not less than ninety (90) days before election, and notify said Board to cause proper notice of the election, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.25, and submit the question of such taxation to all electors with the Village of New Holland, Fayette and Pickaway Counties, Ohio at the general election to be held the November 8, 2022, as provided by law.

SECTION IV: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SECTION V: That Resolution 2016-R11 is amended and any other existing Resolutions or parts specifically in conflict, herewith of the Village of New Holland, Ohio, are hereby repealed.

SECTION VI: That this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of New Holland, for the reason that the Village is in need of continuing funds for the maintenance and operation of the New Holland Union Cemetery and this Resolution must be presented to the Board of Elections and the Auditor of Pickaway County, Ohio within the time period prescribed by law in order to be on the November 8, 2022 ballot, so that this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
