

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF THE QUESTION OF LEVYING AN ADDITIONAL TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF 1.0 MILLS IN EXCESS OF THE 10 MILL LIMITATION TO RUN FOR A DEFINITE PERIOD OF FIVE (5) YEARS FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND, PICKAWAY AND FAYETTE COUNTIES AND DECLARING THIS TO BE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS the amount of taxes which may be raised within ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide adequate amount of the necessary requirements of current expenses of the Village of New Holland, in Pickaway and Fayette Counties, Ohio

WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of New Holland, in Pickaway and Fayette Counties, Ohio, has determined that the amount of taxes that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of the Village of New Holland and therefore there is a need to authorize the Pickaway County Board of Elections to submit to the electors of the Village of New Holland an additional levy for funding the current expenses of the New Holland be placed on the November 5, 2024 ballot

WHEREAS, the County Auditor has certified to the Village that the total current tax valuation of the Village of New Holland is \$15,989,630.00 and the dollar amount of revenue that will be produced annually by the millage stated below would be \$16,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of New Holland is desirous of proceeding with the submission to the electors of the question of levying an additional tax in the amount of 1.0 mill in excess of the 10 mill limitation for the purpose of the current expenses of the Village;

WHEREAS, On May 7, 2024 the Village Council adopted a Resolution to submit to the electors of the Village of New Holland an additional Levy for current expenses Outside the ten-mill limitation, and

WHEREAS, The Pickaway County Auditor has certified to the Village Council that the total current tax valuation of the Village of New Holland is (\$0.10) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation of revenue that will be produced annually by the millage stated for 5 years would be \$16,000 per Year

WHEREAS, It is necessary to levy an additional tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation on the taxable property of the Village of New Holland, in Pickaway and Fayette Counties, Ohio, for a definite period of five (5) years (tax year 2024, 2025, 2026, 2027,2028) at a rate authorized by law for the purpose of funding current expenses of the Village of New Holland;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of New Holland, in Pickaway and Fayette Counties, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION I: That the Council of the Village of New Holland desires and determines to proceed with the submission to the electors of the question of levying an additional tax in excess of the 10 mill limitation for the purpose of funding current expenses of the Village of New Holland at a rate not exceeding 1.0 mill for each \$1.00 of valuation, which amounts to ten cents (\$0.10) for each one hundred dollar (\$100.00) valuation of the taxable property within the Village of New Holland for a period of five (5) years (tax years 2024, 2025, 2026, 2027,2028) of time to be levied in 2024 and collected in 2025, 2026, 2027, 2028, and 2029 as permitted in Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19.

SECTION II: This Resolution is passed pursuant to **Section 5705.19(A)** of the Ohio Revised Code for the current expenses of the Village of New Holland

SECTION III: That the Fiscal Officer of the Village of New Holland be, and herby is, directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections of Pickaway County, Ohio, not less than ninety (90) days before election, and notify said Board to cause proper notice of the election, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.25, and submit the question of such taxation to all electors with the Village of New Holland, in Pickaway and Fayette Counties, Ohio at the general election to be held November 5, 2024 as provided by law.

SECTION IV: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SECTION V: That this Resolution repeals any other existing Resolutions or parts specifically in conflict, herewith of the Village of New Holland, Ohio, are hereby repealed.

SECTION VI: This this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period permitted by law.
